Walker's 26th Annual *Fore the Children*Golf Tournament Raises \$150,000

DEDHAM, Mass. – On Monday October 5, 2015, Walker, a non-profit leader in special education, behavioral health, and residential treatment for children and youth, hosted its 26th Annual *Fore the Children* Golf Tournament. The charity event drew 108 golfers to Dedham Country and Polo Club and raised more than \$150,000 for the children, youth and families served by Walker's therapeutic and academic programs.
